

Do You Know the **FAB FIVE?**

Here is a list of UCS's Fabulous Five resources for your Future. If you ever want to find out what people with a certain major do, research a career field that interests you, establish an externship/internship, look for a job or apply to graduate/professional school, you should become familiar with the following most referenced UCS online resources.

___ **CAVLink** - A listing service which includes externship, internship, part-time and full-time job postings from employers specifically targeting U.Va. students. Also includes job search agents, resume and transcript storage for online job application submission and access to On-Grounds Interviewing (OGI).

___ **CareerSearch** - A comprehensive directory of 1.7 million potential employers which provides a description, the history, size, major competitors and contact information for each company. Narrow your search to find companies that meet your criteria (ie: location, industry, key words, etc). **This resource is only accessible from a UCS library computer. See a UCS staff member for assistance.**

___ **Optimal Resume** - An online tool to help you create, present and manage your resumes. Draft up to 5 resumes using interactive examples and formatting tips, and display them as a website. <http://virginia.optimalresume.com/>

___ **My UCS** - A UCS service which allows you to access Vault, WetFeet, Going Global and other Protected Online Resources such as links to professional journals, directories and job listings. <http://www.career.virginia.edu/>

___ **Vault** - Provides information on business and law school, industry overviews and profiles of top career paths. Also a great resource for tips on securing an internship, interviewing skills, resumes and cover letters.

___ **WetFeet** - Provides information to help college students transition to work or graduate/professional school. Perform industry and company research. Review city profiles. Read advice articles on continuing education, office culture, balancing work and personal life, etc.

___ **Going Global** - Provides information on domestic as well as international opportunities. Search the employer directory and daily job postings as well as read country guides for tips on working or studying in more than 20 countries.

___ **UCAN** - The University Career Assistance Network. A searchable database of 23,000 U.Va alumni available for advice, networking and informational interviewing. The alumni contacts represent various professions and career fields, and are searchable by location, major while at U.Va, industry and company name.
